Our soccer club provides training and games for Under 6 to Under 12 students for both boys and girls. Our club has a proud history of offering our young players a fun and fair opportunity to play soccer during the winter soccer season. Our club plays as part of Central Region Junior Soccer Association (CRJSA). The CRJSA comes under the umbrella of Football Federation Tasmania (FFT). A volunteer committee of dedicated parents runs the St Aloysius Catholic College Soccer Club. Without these Volunteers, we wouldn't have a club, and volunteers for the Committee are always needed.

Trainings are usually after school and games are Saturday morning. Training days are not set until teams and coaches are organised. It usually depends on availability of the coach. At this stage, the soccer season proper is due to commence on the **6th May 2017** and concludes on the **9th September 2017**.

Games are not usually scheduled during the holidays or long weekends, and fixtures are available during the season using the www.crjsa.com.au website.

You can only pay online at the time of registration. We ask that you try to register and pay online as soon as possible after registrations open.

If your child has previously played for St. Aloysius, it is likely that your child will have an “FFT number” already. It can be located on previous emails sent to you regarding your child from FFT, or there is a process on the website through which you can retrieve it if forgotten.

GIRLS SOCCER

There is now an all girls’ soccer roster going so if we get enough girls we can register all girls’ teams in each age group. Other schools now have several girls’ teams participating in this roster. LATE REGISTRATION

Due to team number restrictions enforced by Central Region Junior Soccer Association the committee reserves the right to reject late registrations. Late registrations will be considered, but are dependent on team placement availability.

TEAM ALLOCATION

Once registrations close the committee will assemble teams. We will do our best to make sure that we accommodate requests made for players to be on certain teams or play with their friends, if we can do so. The allocation of players to team groups is a difficult and time consuming task, it involves balancing coach availability, and other considerations. Once team groups are allocated, we ask that you do not approach the committee with requests to change teams.
