Excursions for Senior Drama Students

There are two excursions that the students will be going along to in the next month. The school bus will take the students to and from all of the excursions. Please read the following for details.

Senior Drama will be going on an excursion to **The Theatre Royal** to see a professional production of **Dracula**. The excursion is on the **14th of June** and students will need to **bring** both their **recess and lunch** on the day and wear **formal uniform** for this occasion. The students will all be expected to review this performance for their theory work. This will be due two weeks after the show (5th July).

Senior Drama students will also be taking part in a **Bell Shakespeare workshop**, which focuses on their 2017 production of *The Merchant of Venice*. The workshop will be **Monday 26th June** and students will need to **bring their recess** and **wear formal uniform**. This is an incredible opportunity as Bell Shakespeare Company is one of Australia's most reputable theatrical companies with a worldwide reputation. The workshop will not only enhance their drama skills, but also highlight for them some important ideas about performing Shakespeare and particularly for Yr. 10 the text is part of their current curriculum. Students will be going to see the **Bell Shakespeare production of *The Merchant of Venice* on Friday the 25th of August** and will have to review the performance. We will be travelling to and from The Theatre Royal on a Wisby bus.
