As a progression from the primary learn to swim program, we are once again undertaking an Aquatic Unit during our Health and Physical Education class time at the Clarence Aquatic Centre. This unit will run for 4 weeks during normal PE class time. The structure incorporates stroke correction, fitness and aquatic safety. The main purpose of this unit is to identify and help improve weak swimmers, as well as educating on 'swim survival techniques'. All levels and abilities will be catered for in a supportive manner.

It is very important that we have full participation during this unit. If a student is unable to swim, then a letter to their HPE teacher is essential. This is an important assessment unit and failure to participate will make assessment difficult.

Students are to bring bathers, towel, swimming cap and goggles.
