Dear Parents/Guardians

We are pleased to announce that classes will return to normal at the commencement of Term Three, Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> July. **All classes will return to their original 2018 classrooms.** Over the past ten weeks, a significant amount of work has been completed to return the classrooms to a safe and constructive environment for students and staff.

Please note the following:

- **The gardens and play areas at the Kingston Campus:** specifically the Kinder/Prep playground is still to be restored by external contractors. Kinder and Prep students will use the basketball courts and fort areas for play until their playground is finished.
- **The Library, ICT Room, Art Room and SLN Rooms at Huntingfield** are not complete. The Library will still be located in the Chapel. The Art Room, ICT Room and Workshops will continue to be accessed by external doors.
- **Before and After School Care:** Major works at the terrapin have not yet been completed. Therefore, before and after school care will continue at the Christian Church at Huntingfield. Detailed information will be sent via School Stream.
- **Prep and Kinder Classrooms:** Planning is well underway to significantly redevelop our Early Years block at the end of 2018. We will communicate to parents as these plans come to fruition.

We have produced a number of videos to help support students and families in the transition back to normal classrooms. The links are included with this correspondence. We once again thank parents and guardians in advance for their consideration as we continue restoration of the College. Whilst a considerable amount of work has been completed, in reality we will be working for the rest of the 2018 school year to restore the College to pre-flood conditions.

We will continue to update parents as new information comes to hand via College communication channels.
