Dear Grade Five Students and Parents/Guardians,

Grade 5 camps are next week, so it is an appropriate time to consider the necessary items that should be packed. Also included in this letter are details about what to do when you arrive at school on the morning of your camp. Please note the following dates for the overnight camps:

5 Green – Tuesday 10th and Wednesday 11th April

5 Blue – Wednesday 11th and Thursday 12th April

5 White – Thursday 12th and Friday 12th April

In the morning, there will be a box at the front of the classroom in which to place your shared food items for morning tea. Please remember that our school has a policy of no nuts or nut products. There will also be a box on your teacher's table for any medications. Please make sure that these medications are named and placed in a zip lock bag containing clear, written instructions.

During the evening, we will be playing board and card games, so we ask you to bring along a 'favourite' to share with your classmates. Please label your game, and if you would like us to transport it for you, place it in an area that will be designated by your class teacher.

Your overnight bag will be packed under the bus. You will not be able to access your bag until we arrive at camp. Remember, we are swimming before arriving at camp. Please make sure you have everything that you need for the day packed in a day bag to take on the bus.

The weather can do anything at this time of year, so please make sure you are prepared for all conditions. Make sure you have suitable shoes for the planned activities (sports shoes or something similar).
