GRADE 8 HISTORY EXCURSION

Our Grade 8 students are currently studying Feudal Japan in History. We have arranged for each class to visit Bujinkan Tasmania Dojo-Cho in Macquarie Street, Hobart to participate in a range of immersive activities.

These activities include the Japanese tea ceremony, Samurai skills training, where they will also learn about the Bushido code and Samurai weapons, and also trying on traditional Japanese garments including the Kimono.

Each class will depart the College at 10.30am and return by 1.25pm. Excursion dates are as follows:
