**Vocational Education and Training (VET) Information Evening**

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I write to formally advise you that the **Vocational Education and Training (VET) Information Evening** will be held on Thursday 1 March, 7:00pm to 8:30pm in the Don Bosco Creative Arts Centre at the **Glenorchy Campus of Guilford Young College**. Attendance is expected from all students who are enrolled in VET courses being delivered by our Southern Tasmanian Catholic Colleges Trade Training Centre, and it is a further requirement of your enrolment that parents attend such an information evening to ensure that the demands of the courses are fully understood.
