INTERSCHOOL CHESS TOURNAMENT

Dear Parents/Guardians

The Interschool Chess Tournament is a fun competition of playing 7 rounds of chess with children from other schools. Opponents for each player are selected by computer that are of the same or similar capability (apart from round one).

Parents are free to leave their children at the host school for the day. Students are required to be picked up at 2pm immediately following the awards presentation.

RULES:

- Team members will need to shake their opponent's hand at the beginning and end of each game.
- You will need to play the 'touch move' rule; If students touch a piece then that is the piece you have to move. Students should take their time and look at all of the options before making a move.
- If students touch their opponent's king the game will immediately end.
- Students will be using clocks for each game and will be taught how to use them correctly prior to the commencement of the tournament.
- Students are reminded that while they are in their sports uniform they need to follow the 'Be Attitudes' expectations at all times when representing the college.
