### **Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) Certificate**

As part of the VET Hospitality at St Aloysius Catholic College, our students undertake training in the responsible service of alcohol. The Responsible Service of Alcohol (RSA) course is conducted at the College by TasTAFE.

In consideration of the level of student interest in this qualification, the College has decided to offer this opportunity to Grade 10 students enrolled in the VET hospitality program. The RSA qualification is a legal requirement for any person involved in serving alcohol in restaurants, hotels or even sporting clubs. Students considering seeking casual or full time employment in the hospitality sector may wish to enrol in the College training day.

Please note that this course is a full day of training and participating students will be required to catch up on any missed work from their regular lessons in their own time. The course is theory based and does not involve practical work or the actual serving of alcohol.

The RSA course will be conducted on Wednesday 16th August. All students who complete the training are issued with a nationally recognised certificate in Responsible Service of Alcohol.
