Soccer training is usually after school during the week with games on a Saturday morning. Training days/times are not set until teams and coaches are allocated, as it will depend on the availability of the coach.

The 2019 soccer season will commence on Saturday 4th May 2019.

Games are generally not scheduled during the holidays or long weekends. Fixtures are available during the season by accessing the CRJFA website (www.crjfa.com.au) and following the "Rosters" link.

Registrations open Friday 8th March at 5pm and will close on Friday 22nd March at 5pm.

A Working with Vulnerable People permit is essential and you will be required to register as a coach/volunteer via the www.playfootball.com.au/register website. The committee will provide the instructions to each coach as they are confirmed.

Late Registration

Due to team number restrictions enforced by CRJFA the committee reserves the right to reject late registrations. ***Late registrations will only be considered if there is relevant team placement availability.***

Team Allocation

Once registrations close the committee will assemble teams. We will do our best to make sure that we accommodate requests made for players to be on certain teams or play with their friends, if we are able to do so. The allocation of players to team groups is a difficult and time consuming task, it involves balancing coach availability, previous team allocations and other considerations. Once team groups are allocated, we ask that you do not approach the committee with requests to change team allocation.
