## Urgently Seeking Plant Stall Coordinator for 2017

### What does it involve?

- Attend Fair Meetings when possible and keep in touch with Fair Committee.
- Organise team of helpers.
- Labelling and pricing of donated plants.
- Organising collection and storage of plants prior to Fair Day.
- Getting set up on the Saturday before Fair Day.
- Fair Day start approx. 8.30am to 3.30pm
- **Support, advice and detailed handover are available from outgoing Coordinator and Fair Committee.**
- All stall coordinators are required to hold a current WWVPC in addition to a current National Police Check.

### **WITHOUT A COORDINATOR THERE WILL BE NO PLANT STALL!**

#### SOME OPTIONS TO CONSIDER

The Plant Stall need not be the same every year. If you have different ideas about how it should be run, your ideas are welcome!

The Plant Stall need not be a huge and complex stall. You might consider a different or smaller scale option such as

- Cut Flower and Fresh Produce Stall
- Seedlings Stall
- Succulents Stall
- Bagged Manure Stall

**REMEMBER THAT YOU ARE NOT EXPECTED TO DO EVERYTHING. THERE ARE PLENTY OF WILLING GROWERS, HELPERS AND ADVICE, BUT WE NEED A COORDINATOR TO BE IN CHARGE OF THE STALL**

### What can the College & Parish do to assist the Plant Stall?

- Start collecting ice cream containers, plant pots, icy-pole sticks (for labels) etc.
- Start potting self-sown seedlings and taking stem and root cuttings to ensure good growth by November.
- Vegetable and ornamental seeds should be sown 6-8 weeks before the fair (depending on variety) so start early-mid September to ensure they are ready for Fair day.
- Semi-hardwood cuttings of deciduous ornamentals: viburnum/snowball tree, weigela/apple blossom etc. These can be taken in Winter after leaves have fallen.
- Cuttings of salvia, hydrangea, geraniums, abutilon/chinese lanterns, buddleia etc. These can be taken any time before new buds are too developed.
- Self-rooting sections of jasmine, strawberry runners etc. These can be potted any time roots have developed.
- Succulents: stem cuttings should be left in a shaded spot for at least 7-10 days before potting (helps prevent rotting by drying cut stem). Don't allow potting mixture to be too wet over winter. Leaves of some succulents can be left on surface of pots to start new plants.
- Bulbs: once foliage has died some bulbs can be lifted and potted before new roots and leaves are too advanced.
- Rhizomes: irises, arum lilies, red hot poker, cannas, ginger lilies etc. Clumps can be separated once old growth has died or been cut off.
- Please indicate name/flower colour on a label. Cheap labels can be made from cut up ice-cream/yoghurt containers. Laundry marker writing will last a few months.

### Urgently Seeking Hot Chips Stall Coordinator for 2017

#### What does it involve?

- Attend Fair Meetings when possible and keep in touch with Fair Committee.
- Organise team of helpers – at least 3 persons needed to run the stall on the day
- Organising the supply of cookers and gas bottles, ordering chips, sauce and other consumables
- Setting up cookers and start heating up oil at least 1 hour prior to Fair start. Ensure that the public are protected from hot burners.
- Fair Day start approx. 9.00am to 3.30pm
- A busy day cooking and serving delicious chips to happy customers!
- clean up
- **Support, advice, contact names and suppliers and detailed handover are available from outgoing Coordinator and Fair Committee.**
- All stall coordinators are required to hold a current WWVPC in addition to a current National Police Check.

### Urgently Seeking Fair Wheel Coordinator for 2017

#### What does it involve?

- Liaise with Fair Raffle Coordinator and Fair Collections Coordinator to source prizes for the Fair Wheel
- Organise team of helpers – about 6 persons needed to run the stall on the day
- Sort and wrap prizes attractively for display on Fair Day and arrange suitable storage.
- Set up the Fair Wheel and prize display area (support and assistance is provided)
- Fair Day start approx. 9.00am to 3.30pm
- A busy day with you and your team selling tickets, announcing the spins, spinning the Wheel and calling out the ticket colours and winning numbers – again and again.....
- be prepared to adapt and go with the weather and other circumstances on the day
- clean up
